3) HOW TO SIGN UP FOR THE CLASSES:

It's easy!!! On our webpage www.bettercompanion.com, use the menu bar on the left. You'll find a button "Classes", with the subtitle "Registration", which brings you directly to the one registration form for ALL classes and workshops. After clicking "enroll" at the end, you'll get to the pricing and payment page, which explains all payment options, policies, and allows you to pay online, too. You can also check out the pricing page first, to learn about prices, payment and cancellation policies. Please note that some workshops have their own cancellation policy, even though they use the same registration form as the classes. Take advantage of our pre-registration fee by signing up a minimum of 14 days before the start of your class. Different deadlines might apply to some of the workshops and seminars.

<u>Puppy 1 Preschool clients</u>, please remember you can also purchase the <u>Puppy School Packet</u>, including P1 and P2 class. You only have to commit to the six weeks of P1 class, and will receive a voucher for P2, valid for 1 full year! For <u>P2 voucher holders</u>, the voucher will be your payment. After you fill out the registration form for P2, you can email us the voucher number, mail the voucher to us or drop it off at the facility.

Reserve your spot! Please note our registration policy: Only the payment will hold your spot. Spots are reserved in the order we receive payment for them. Always sign up for the class you want to join, even if it could be full. Only the payment will keep you on the waiting list, in case somebody else drops out before the class starts. Your payment is never lost, even if the class is already full. Your payment will 1) save you a spot at the class, or 2) save you a spot on the waiting list, or 3) can be carried over to a later class, or 4) can be refunded if I couldn't get you in the class you chose, or 5) can cause me to open an overflow class ©. Just as a note: I sometimes get up to three dogs per class moved in from a waiting list before the class even starts. We can take credit card payments over the phone and at the facility.

4) Doggy Daycare and Open Play Times:

<u>Doggy Daycare:</u> Offered on Tuesdays and Thursdays 6am-7pm, with their playtime ending at 5pm, at which time they'll be kenneled if not picked up before. Call us for details.

We'll be closed on July 5th in observance of Independence Day.

<u>Open Play Time:</u> Come with your dog for one hour of dog play and dog owner social time. Each dog must be supervised by an adult handler, one dog per handler only. <u>Vaccinated dogs only</u> (5-way/DHPPi, dogs over 6 mo: Rabies, Bordetella). We also require having the dog <u>dewormed or a fecal sample checked</u>.

No OPT on May 25th (Memorial Day Weekend) and July 6th (week of Independence Day)

<u>First-timers:</u> bring your <u>vaccination papers</u>, we want to see them! Larger dogs over 6 months, please call us before your first visit, so that we can decide together which hour would be best for your dog, and if we need to evaluate your dog first. We offer evaluations on Fridays at 8pm (see below).

Fee: \$7 at the door or punch card \$35 for a 6 visit punch card.

Our Open Play Times (indoors + outdoors, depending on the season and weather) have become a safe playground for dogs of any size due to our size restrictions for each group. Only timid and absolutely non-reactive dogs can be slightly heavier than the group limit. The group from 6-7pm (medium dogs) is limited to 12 dogs and the group from 7-8pm (large dogs) is limited to 8 dogs. Reservations can be made in advance. At this time no reservations are needed for the group from 5-6pm (small dogs/puppies). Your dog can get on the waitlist and you will be called if we have a cancellation. If you reserved a spot for your dog in OPT, didn't show that day and we had someone on the waitlist, you WILL be charged for that day even though you weren't there. Just call us and we explain the details.

Every Friday (not before holiday weekends e.g. Memorial Day, Labor Day, ...):

5-6pm: puppies, toy and small dogs up to 25#

6-7pm: puppies and medium adult dogs 30-50# (giant breed puppies can be heavier)

7-8pm: Large adult dogs over 60# (indoors: 8 dogs max; outdoors: 10 dogs max)

8-9pm: By appointment only -for evaluations. \$35/half hour

5) DOG SCOUTS OF AMERICA

Excerpts from their web page: www.dogscouts.org:

Dog Scouts of America (DSA) was established in 1995. It is a non-profit organization people who are dedicated to enriching their lives and the lives of others with dogs. **Founder, Lonnie Olson**, has made it her life's ambition to experience as many dog sports and skills as possible with her dogs. If you believe that dogs really enjoy learning new things and spending time with their owners, you're our kind of dog person. Dogs were not meant to be "furniture." Working dogs want to work. Without having an acceptable activity in which to use up all of that energy that comes "built-in" with a dog, our canine companions often get into trouble. By better understanding how your dog thinks, how he learns, and what drives his behavior, and by participating in a variety of dog sports and activities, you will become a more responsible dog owner. We hope to prevent misunderstandings, communication failures and behavioral problems which often lead to dogs being given up as a "lost cause".

<u>Lonnie's motto</u>: "Our dog's lives are much shorter than ours - let's help them enjoy their time with us as much as we can."

<u>Mission statement</u>: To improve the lives of dogs, their owners, and society through humane education, positive training, and community involvement.

<u>Training approach</u>: To promote humane treatment of animals, DSA advocates only the most modern, scientific, behavioral approaches to training. DSA teaches the owners that everything you need to communicate to a dog can be done with operant conditioning, and without the use of force, punishment or abuse.

<u>Joining</u>: You can become a member and sign up your dog(s) as well. Your dogs become "Cadet Scouts" immediately. Then any dog can become a **Dog Scout**. The only requirement is that the dog and owner must be able to pass a test, proving that the owner is responsible and the dog is well mannered and not a danger toward humans and other dogs. This test is partly online for the owner and partly videotaping the dog's behavior in public in certain situations. Once there's a Dog Scout instructor and evaluator available in Alaska, the test can be taken directly without videotaping.

Merit badge system: You can only earn badges after you and your dog passed the Dog Scout Test. There are uncountable different badges your dog can earn. After learning and performing a particular skill, the owner will receive a patch to attest to the accomplishment. **Examples for badges** are: Backpacking, Hiking, Biking, Letterboxing, Geocaching, Camping, Cani-cross; various badges for water activities, agility, obedience, nose work, pulling and community services; Phodography, Sign Language, Retrieve, Fundraising, Temperament Test (ATTS), Scent Hurdle, Triathadog, First Aid, Dog Care, Travel Safety, Disaster Prep, K-9 Fitness, Hunt Retriever, Lure Coursing, Steeplechase, Herding, Flyball, Frisbee (Distance), Frisbee (Freestyle), Earth dog, Treibball...

Other activities: Hike-a-thon, dog scout camps, DSA sanctioned competitions ...

Did you get curious? Time to go to www.dogscouts.org and check out those badges! I'm sure you and your dog can earn at least some of them!
